LEARN ABOUT YOUR STUDENTS ACTIVITY: “Career Collage: When I grow up...” It is never too early to start a conversation about Careers and Colleges. Learn about your students and their hopes for the future by creating a Career Collage. Take photos of the students holding a sign of what career they would like to have when they grow up. This is a fun activity to repeat at the end of the year to see if the students change their career track.

*Make sure you have your teacher’s permission to photograph your mentees.

WHY IT’S IMPORTANT:

- Begins a career conversation with your students
- Helps mentors learn about their students and their names

NEEDS:

- Camera
- Chalk board, white board or other handheld sign that students can use to write their future career on
- Markers or chalk for the handheld sign
- Picmonkey or another free photo editing system

DIRECTIONS:

1. Start a conversation with your students about their future career. Ask each student to think of what career they would like to have when they grow up.
2. Have each student write their future career on the handheld sign.
3. Take the photo of the student holding the sign.

4. Once all pictures have been taken, upload the images and create a collage using Picmonkey.com or another photo editing software.
5. Create a collage for your classroom and print out the finished product for your teacher.
6. Repeat at the end of the school year to see if your students have changed their minds about their future professions.
